SELF GUIDED

FAMILY ART TRAIL

- Follow this trail to discover some of Brockley's most interesting murals and learn more about their artists.
- Route: *Brockley Station to Hilly Fields*, Distance: *2km approx* Time: *45 minutes*

LOOK OUT!

Some of our artists are out and about painting. See brockleystreetart.com/artists for a list of locations. Please stop them and say hello!

1 Starting by Brockley Station:

Stand on the corner of Coulgate Street opposite the Brockley Barge. What famous 1970's reggae icon do you see?

What is the name of the artist printed at the top left hand side of the mural?

FACT: This is the third time this musical icon has been painted in this location, with the original mural (now lost) dating back over 40 years ago.

3 Turn left, past Sainsbury's crossing over at the crossing outside Prestige Barbers. Follow the pavement around to the bottom of Geoffrey Road.

Here you will find Louis Masai's work The Last Roar, showing an endangered Bengal tiger. Endangered means it is at risk of being lost forever. This is no laughing matter, but what is the amusing name of the restaurant located next to their fearsome creature?

4 Heading back under the bridge, what appears to have escaped onto the wall of the Doorstep Bakery? Who is the artist?

FACT: Louis Masai has also painted one of his famous bees on the front of Beecroft Garden Primary School in Crofton Park, highlighting the location's original use as a bee farm.

7 Follow St Margarets Road, heading up Chalsey Road to Hilly Fields.

LOOK OUT! As you head up the path towards Pistachio's, you might spot Lionel Stanhope's Hilly Fields painted on the football shed gates.

Head around the back of the cafe and you'll find a bandstand mural by BecknCol.

Copy this bandstand or design your own below.

5 Continue to the corner of Harefield Road at Mira Off License to Clare Astruc's colourful image of a flying elderly musician.

What musical instrument is the old man playing?

What is this artist's street name? (Clue: look for the sign coming from the vent.)

6 Continue along Brockley Road past St Andrew's Church to the corner of Sid's Plumbing shop. Which famous American jazz, soul and funk musician is featured in this mural painted by Richard Wilson?

What is the name of the song that these lyrics are taken from?
